



Flat Stanley Summer Reading Project

Directions:

1. Read Flat Stanley; His Original Adventure!
2. Decorate your own Flat Stanley using the attached Flat Stanley outline.
3. Take along Flat Stanley on your summer vacation or family outing and bring back pictures of the places Flat Stanley visits. Pictures and postcards are not mandatory; however, I will award extra credit for pictures or postcards included in the project.
4. When Flat Stanley is finished with his travels, please complete the following Flat Stanley Reading Project; due the second Friday of the new school year.

5. The first two things your child will need for this project is a poster board and a pencil. On the poster board, students will draw two lines, sectioning the poster board into four sections (one horizontal line and one vertical line). They should be sectioned off evenly into four equal squares.

6. Students will use each of the 4 sections to describe the main ideas of the story. Each section should only require 3-4 sentences. The four sections are:

1. Characters
2. Setting
3. Plot
4. Conflict/Resolution.

7. Once they are done writing, students will glue their Flat Stanley to the poster board and then decorate the rest of the poster board themselves. Some students may choose to add a few pictures from their adventures with Stanley or draw some of their own. They may decorate their poster however they like. This will help me get to know them as one of my new second grade friends!
